ACCOMMODATION

Camping with showers and toilets available. Fires allowed. If you need help with camping equipment - advise when booking on ChurchSuite. Pillars of Hercules also has a shop and vegetarian café.

VENUE / TRAVEL

Pillars of Hercules, Falkland near Glenrothes.

Travel is one hour by car or public transport. Train to Glenrothes and then bus to Falkland. The number 64 bus goes directly from Glenrothes to the campsite.

COST

For the weekend;

£30 Individual pitch
£35 Adult and (school-aged) child
£50 Couple pitch
£60 Family pitch (up to 2 school aged children)
£65 Family pitch (3+ school aged children)

For Day visitors;

£5 for an individual
£10 per family
