ACCOMMODATION

Camping with showers and toilets available. Fires allowed. If you need help with camping equipment - advise when booking on ChurchSuite. Pillars of Hercules also has a shop and vegetarian café.

Travel is one hour by car or public transport. Train to Glenrothes and then bus to Falkland. The number **64** bus goes directly from Glenrothes to the campsite.
